



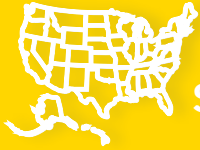

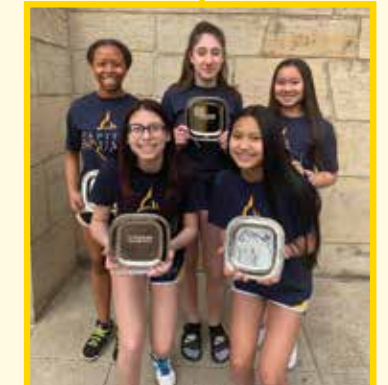
**Inaugural Capitol Cup**

Pediatric residents served as academic mentors, gave health presentations, and ensured all students either had primary care physicians or were able to get physicals.



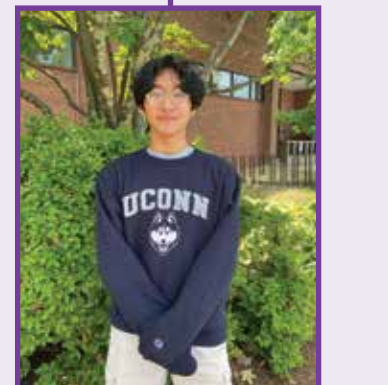
**First Annual David Kinsley Award**
